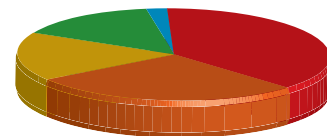

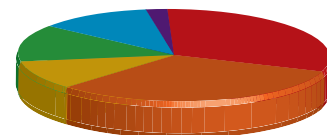
EXPECTED AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION

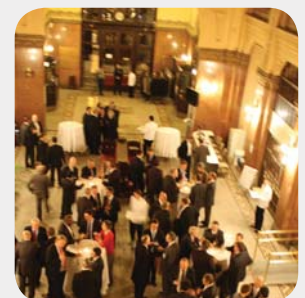

The installations for crude oil processing in the Grupa LOTOS refinery in Gdansk were constructed under the 10+ Programme. In the last three years 50 installations were erected on the refinery's premises, thanks to which the Gdansk Refinery increased crude oil throughput capacity by 75% and contributes to increasing energy safety of the entire country.

It produces ultra low-sulfur diesel, petrol, heavy fuel oil (HFO), liquefied petroleum gas (LPG), light heating oil, bunker oils, jet fuel, base oils and bitumen. The refinery obtains supplies of crude oil from a terminal in the northern port of Gdansk and also the Przyjazn pipeline.

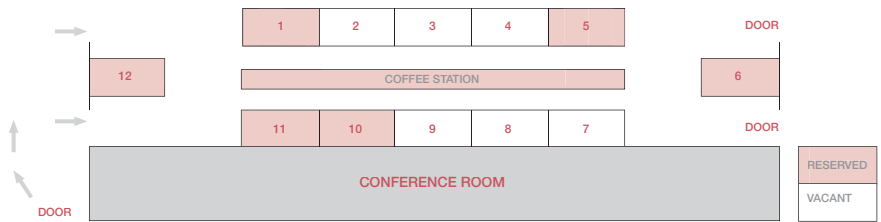
